

**Marion Central School District
Board of Education
Information Sheet**

If you are interested in becoming a candidate for a seat on the Marion Board of Education, we hope this fact sheet will inform and assist you in the process.

Elections will be held **Tuesday, May 21, 2024**, from **12:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m.**, in the Elementary School Auditorium.

The one (1) candidate who receive the greatest number of votes will serve a three-year term beginning July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2027.

The Board member whose term is expiring this year: Michele Kuelling

To be a **board of education candidate**, an individual must be:

1. a U.S. Citizen
2. at least 18 years of age
3. able to read and write
4. a district resident for one year prior to the May 21, 2024 election
5. not employed by the school district

The District Clerk must receive petitions no later than **5:00 p.m., on Monday, April 22, 2024**, at the District Office located at 4034 Warner Rd., Marion New York.

Petitions must bear signatures of at least **25 residents** eligible to vote in the Marion election on May 21, 2024. A voter may sign petitions for more than one candidate.

To be an **eligible voter**, an individual must be:

1. a U.S. citizen
2. at least 18 years of age
3. a district resident for 30 days (or more) prior to the May 21, 2024 vote

Candidates will be asked to introduce themselves at the Budget Hearing on **Tuesday, May 7, 2024 in the Marion Jr-Sr High Library**.
