## Marion Central School District Board of Education Information Sheet

If you are interested in becoming a candidate for a seat on the Marion Board of Education, we hope this fact sheet will inform and assist you in the process.

Elections will be held <u>Tuesday</u>, <u>May 21, 2024</u>, from 12:00 p.m. – 8:00 p.m., in the Elementary School Auditorium.

The one (1) candidate who receive the greatest number of votes will serve a three-year term beginning July 1, 2024 through June 30, 2027.

The Board member whose term is expiring this year: Michele Kuelling

To be a **board of education candidate**, an individual must be:

- 1. a U.S. Citizen
- 2. at least 18 years of age
- 3. able to read and write
- 4. a district resident for one year prior to the May 21, 2024 election
- 5. not employed by the school district

The District Clerk must receive petitions no later than **5:00 p.m., on Monday, April 22, 2024,** at the District Office located at 4034 Warner Rd., Marion New York.

Petitions must bear signatures of at least **25 residents** eligible to vote in the Marion election on <u>May 21, 2024</u>. A voter may sign petitions for more than one candidate.

To be an **eligible voter**, an individual must be:

- 1. a U.S. citizen
- 2. at least 18 years of age
- 3. a district resident for 30 days (or more) prior to the May 21, 2024 vote

Candidates will be asked to introduce themselves at the Budget Hearing on Tuesday, May 7, 2024 in the Marion Jr-Sr High Library.
