- A1. CALL TO ORDER** Mrs. Kuelling called the meeting to order at 6:01 P.M. and led the Pledge of Allegiance.
- A4. APPROVAL OF AGENDA** Motion by Mr. Reesor, seconded by Mr. Monroe and unanimously carried by Board members present the following resolution: BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Education, upon the recommendation of the Superintendent of Schools and pursuant to Education Law, approves the agenda of January 23, 2023 with the deletion of the two discussion bullets under Board of Education Reports. - B. COMM AGENDA COMMENTS** An opportunity for community questions and comments on agenda items was given. No comments were made.
- C. PRESENTATIONS** Mrs. Lachnor, along with six members of the Marion Chapter of FFA (Rebecca VanCamp, Haden Williams, Aeris Maynard, Emery Sirkin, Gracie Evans and Caleb Smith), presented the on FFA's resents events and activities. The Marion Chapter has about 40 members. They have gone on field trips to places like Cornell Agritech and Crackerbox Palace, have held events such as an egg hunt, school dance, and FFA Day and Mrs. Lachnor and Miss VanCamp attended the National Convention which was a first for both of them and a great opportunity to connect and network with other districts.
